PRESIDENTIAL HOTLINE OUTREACH AND AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS

NORTHERN CAPE AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

The Presidential Hotline partnered with the Northern Cape Provincial Government (Office of the Premier) to create awareness and educate the community about how the Hotline works. The campaign took place between 8 to 15 November 2015 in the Nama-Khoi and Kareeberg Municipalities. The towns visited under the two municipalities were Springbok, Concordia, Okiep, Nababeep, Maandtjiekloof, Bersig, Carnavon, Vosberg, Britstown, Prieska, Douglas, Campbel and Smitdsdrift.

The awareness campaigns involve the distribution of pamphlets and posters to the main centres such as hospitals, clinics, Thusong Centres, community radios and libraries. The citizens were happy to interact with the officials from the Presidential Hotline.

The Presidential Hotline participated in the Eastern Cape's PLO Forum. The event was held on 25 to 26 November 2015 at Senqu Municipality, in the Joe Gqabi District Municipality. This event was organized and coordinated by the Provincial Presidential Hotline Management team in the Office of the Premier.

The purpose of the Forum was to provide support in improving the speed and quality of case resolution. In addition to this, the Hotline team provided guidance on how to record the resolution of cases appropriately using the newly developed guidelines.
